Introductory Statement

The Bridge Satellites is a school for pupils with a diagnosis of autism. The Bridge Satellites provide specialist provision over a number of bases, which are close to mainstream schools, enabling inclusion opportunities. All pupils who attend The Bridge Satellites are able to access the National Curriculum.

Admissions to the School

The Bridge Satellite is a co-educational special school, which when full will provide 90 places for children and young people in the age range 4 to 19 with a diagnosis of autism.

At present the school is in temporary accommodation and is only able to provide places for pupils in the year 2-9 age group range.

For a child to be admitted, the school must be named by a local authority in the child's education, health and care plan ('EHCP').

Parents wishing their children to benefit from this provision should specify this to the Local Authority area in which they reside when their child's EHCP is being discussed.
